Activity: Monopoly Run	Type: Walking, City, Exploring	Location: London	Event Date: 18 th April 2020
Description: Team Competition travelling by foot and public transport to visit locations around London. Teams comprising 4-7 Scouts/Explorers/Network Scouts and Leaders			

Hazard	Who might be harmed?	Risk Control Measures	Notes / Review / Revision
Getting Lost	Participant	Each participant issued with start/end information and Emergency contact numbers. Teams monitored at key locations. Safety and guideline issued at start. Teams carry charge mobile device, and/or obtain street & underground maps. Team members to agree meeting point if separated.	
Trips and falls	Participant	Participants complete together as a team. Suitable footwear and clothing to be worn. Emergency phone numbers provided to every participant.	
Moving vehicles	Participant	Participants must use designated crossing points and subways, and ensure to be observant when crossing roads.	
Risk of illness	Participant	Team members to monitor welfare of each other. Suitable clothing and footwear to be worn. Teams encouraged to carry small first aid kit. Adequate food and water to be carried.	
Viruses & colds	Participants/public	Wash hands with soap and water often and use hand sanitiser if available. Avoid close contact to others who are coughing, sneezing or who may have a fever. Reduce contact with surfaces, and avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth. Use a tissue instead of your hand if you cough or sneeze, and dispose of in a bin.	
Theft/ assault	Participant	Team information sheet detailing safety of self and personal items. Participants to stay together as a team. All valuables kept out of sight.	
Loss of ticket/personal items	Participant	Participants to ensure items kept safe and secure in pockets or secure bags. Participants to have money to purchase another ticket if necessary.	
Major incident – terrorism/ organised crime; public disorder	Participant/public	Participants to follow Police instruction and emergency procedures. Emergency contact numbers provided to each participant. Inform participants at start to avoid specific areas if risk of incident is known.	
Crowds	Participant	Flexible start/end time to ensure minimal crowd issues at station. Safety guidelines issued to ensure awareness of crowds and proximity of others at popular locations, stations and on trains.	
Transport restriction	Participant	Teams to monitor by use of mobile device, and/or street and underground maps. Each participant issued with start/end location information and Emergency numbers
